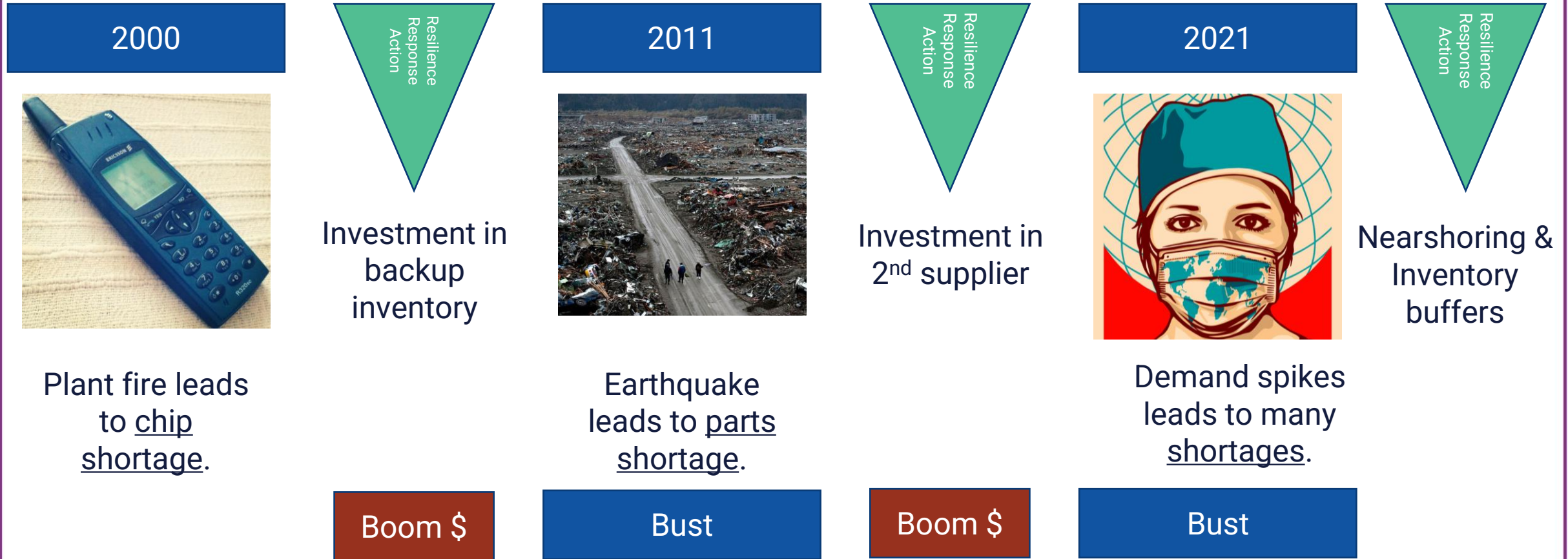

The Boom / Bust Effect

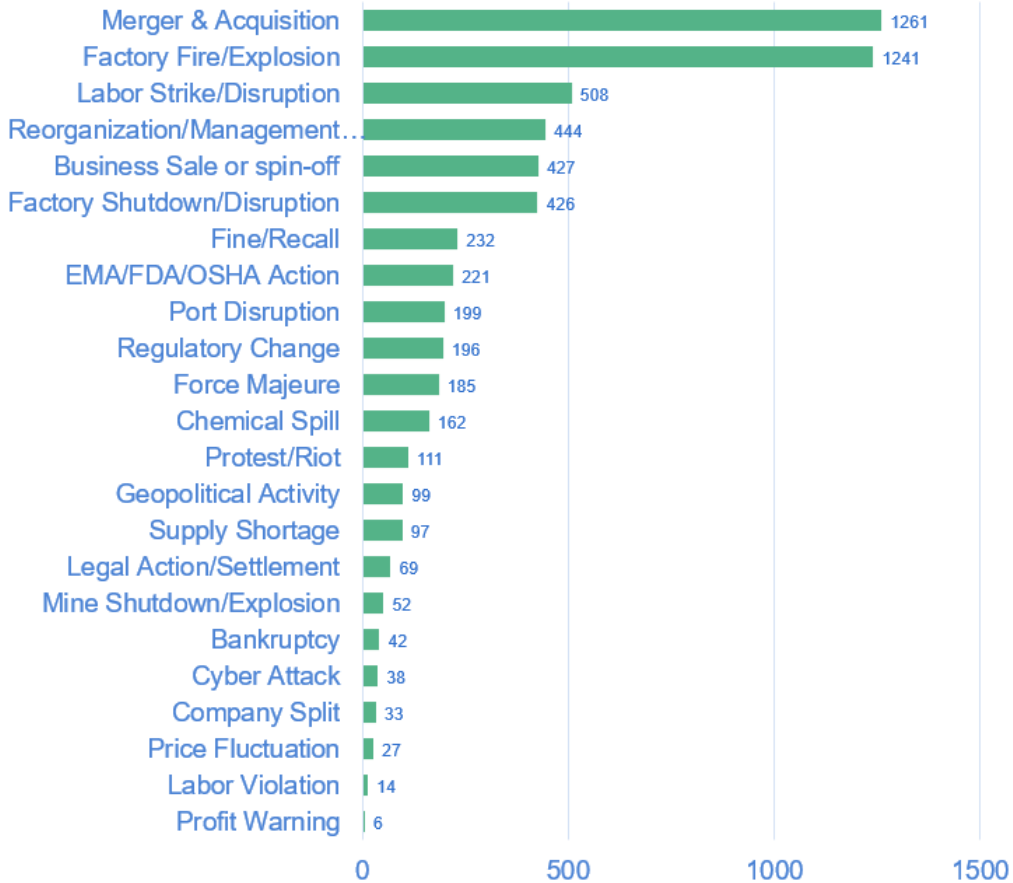

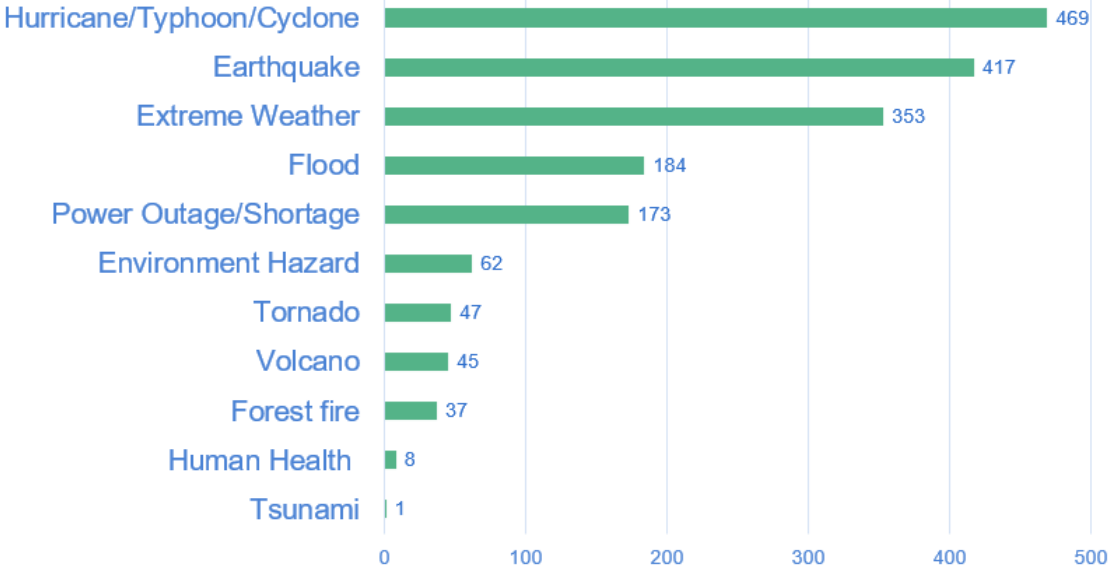
Takeaway: Different events, “same consequences” drive the need for capabilities rather than risk management.

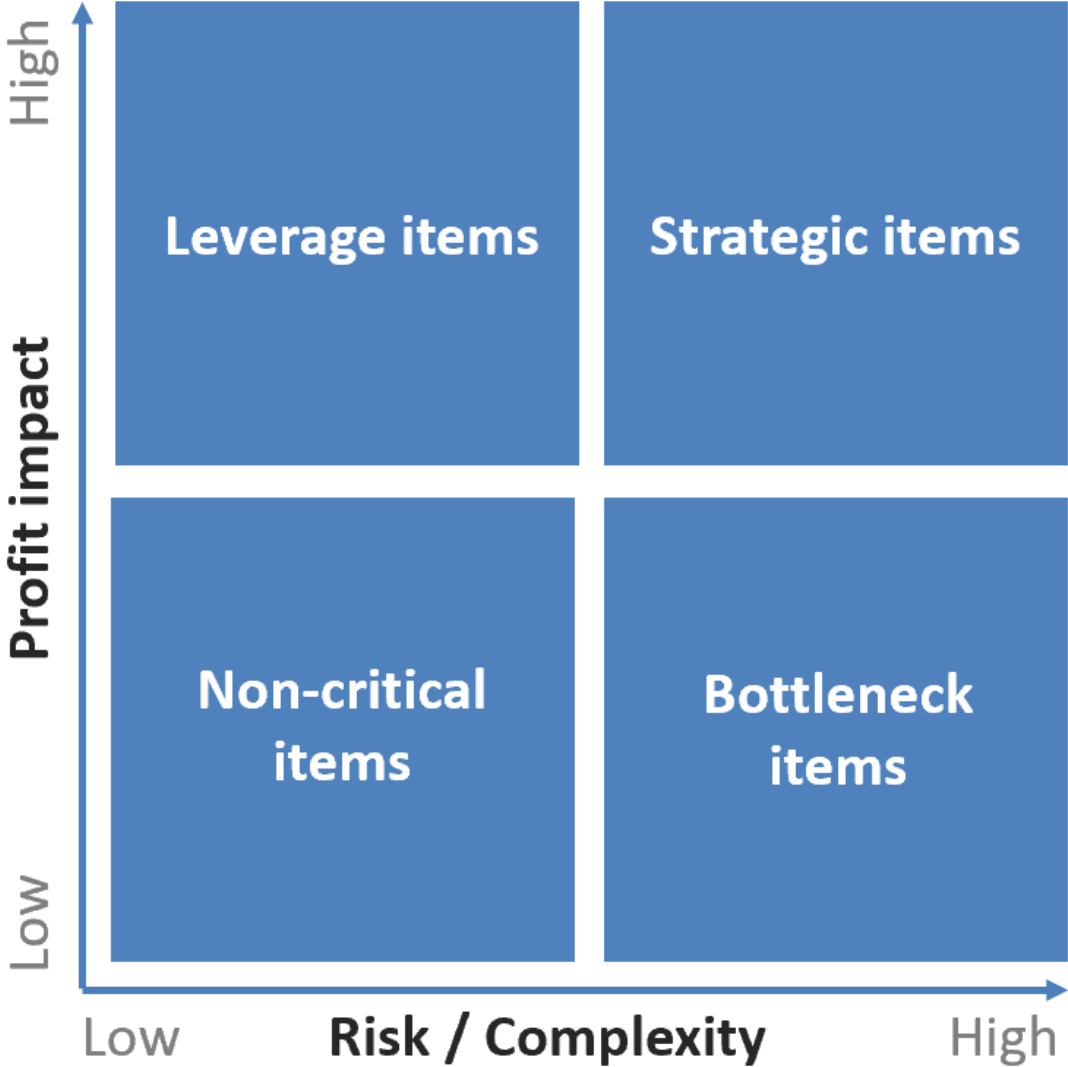
